

# → Overview

This Conference will provide practitioners and academics alike with the opportunity to learn about the most significant tort law developments in Europe in 2015. Experts from across the continent will present highlights from their contributions to the Yearbook, European Tort Law 2015, which will be published after the Conference. An overview of developments in EU law will also be provided, and a concluding summary will identify and assess the most important emerging trends.

The Conference begins on Thursday evening with an opening lecture by Catherine M Sharkey (New York University School of Law) and concludes with a special session on Liability for Unknown Risks on Saturday morning. Throughout the Conference, there will be ample opportunity for discussion and debate, both in the formal proceedings and during the breaks.

The Conference and Yearbook are a collaboration between the European Centre of Tort and Insurance Law (ECTIL), an independent association, and the Institute for European Tort Law of the Austrian Academy of Sciences and the University of Graz (ETL).
